At this stage you have not provided the Tribunal with any material from your current treating practitioner concerning the specific issues you have raised in your email. I note that Dr Moyle's correspondence of 26 April 2007 (@T49 of the T-documents) has not provided a diagnosis of your condition which specifically requires, from a medical treatment viewpoint, that the format of the interaction with the Tribunal be as you have requested in your email.

In closing I should point out that ss42A(2) of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975 enables the Tribunal to dismiss a matter where the applicant fails to appear for that listed event (be it in-person or by telephone).
